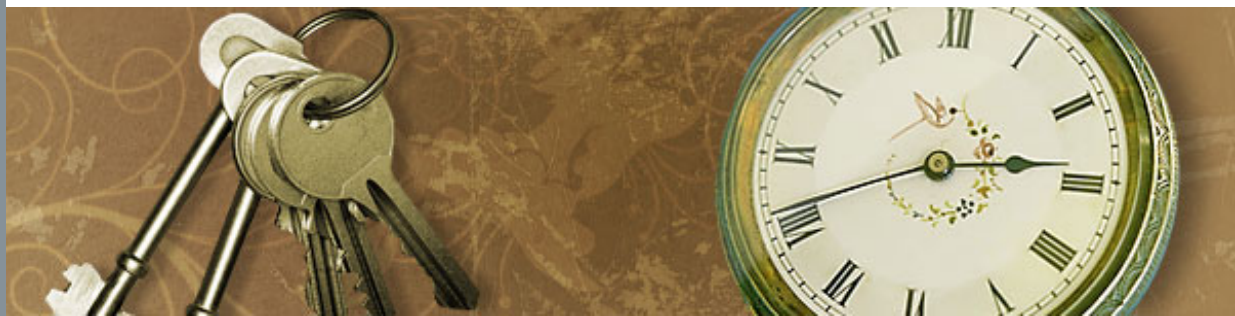

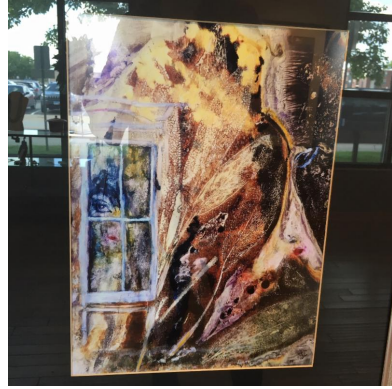
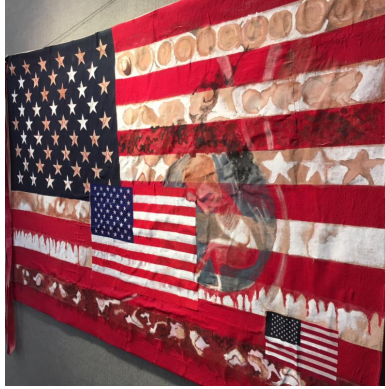

Peace, Love & Understanding: running from Thursday August 15- Sunday September 15, 2019. No commissions on sales, no application fee. We supply gallery sitter and sales fulfillment. There will be opening and closing parties as well as events during the run of the show to drive foot traffic.

We are at the 50th anniversary of Woodstock, and while this exhibit is not about Woodstock, it shares some of the themes around the subjects of nations, people of different backgrounds, religions, tribes if you will, coming together to find commonality and work together for the better good. 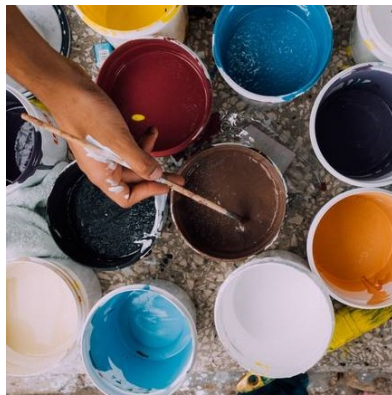
