Riverwalk Fine Art Fair Recap

The Riverwalk Fine Art Fair (RFAF), NAL's signature event, returned to its full glory this year, much to the delight of the 110 artists and thousands of art fair-goers who welcomed them. Sunshine and seasonal temperatures contributed to the event's success, with participants citing easy setup and great sales as influencing factors. RFAF has earned the elite status of being a well-run, organized show, and over 50 volunteers were on site to ensure the reputation stays intact.

Artists, impressed with the personal attention they received, reported their delight. From the time they arrived, artists received support from helpful NAL representatives that were helpful, efficient, and courteous. Extra amenities like the artists' breakfast and bottled water were mentioned often, and all agreed that RFAF is an artist-focused fair. These elements play a role in the show's placement on Sunshine Artist's Top 100 Best Art Fairs in the Country, and NAL is proud of its ranking and the members that help make it possible.

BOARD NOTES FROM SEPTEMBER 2022

What is Development?

"Development" is critical to the financial health of the NAL, but what does it mean?

Development basically means continuing to develop a stream of financial resources to keep a non-profit like the Naperville Art League in business. Development funds can be requested and used to support the general operating costs of the Gallery and Studio, or they can support events, or programs, or special opportunities that the league deems appropriate.

Typically, these funds come as a result of grants the NAL submits to various funders. These funders can include local affiliates of larger companies (e.g. Walmart, Costco, Nicor), municipal and civic organizations, national corporations, and private foundations.

The NAL currently has number of grant submissions pending, with more going in soon. It is an ongoing process that, between research and final decision, can take up to 4-6 months for the larger monetary awards.

The world of development and grantmaking is huge, and there are many resources to tap, so if any members happen to learn of a funding opportunity we may be eligible for, please pass it along.
